The challenge

- AWS
- Azure
- VM's hosted at us
- VM's hosted at customer
- Physical machines

Our solution

- Logical Volume Manager (LVM)
- Create snapshots of /opt
- Patch/update servers
- Delete snapshots

If update fails, rollback snapshot
